

2026 DAY OF PRAYER GRANT APPLICATION & ENDORSEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

APPLICATION & ENDORSEMENT DEADLINE: MARCH 15, 2026

Criteria

- Projects requesting grants must be affiliated with a BWNA member body and include an endorsement from a current leader within that member body who is not directly involved in the project.
- 2. Before applying, please review the list of <u>BWNA member bodies</u>.
- 3. Projects must occur within North America, with primary benefactors being women and/or children.
- 4. Preference will be given to projects that:
- 5. Improve the quality of life for disadvantaged women
- 6. Offer leadership development or training opportunities
- 7. Provide care and education for children
- 8. Projects involving "bricks and mortar" construction or staff salaries are discouraged.
- 9. Grant awards will range from \$500 to \$5,000.
- 10. Applicants will be notified of outcomes by June 15, 2026.
- 11. Progress reports are required; failure to provide one may result in loss of eligibility for future funding.
- 12. Successful applicants will receive grant funds in mid-July 2026.

Instructions for Completing the Forms

- 1. Please type, print, or use block capitals when completing the application.
- 2. Use only the official application and endorsement forms provided. You may include additional information to supplement these forms.
- 3. The BWNA Day of Prayer Project Grant Application Form must be filled out completely and include a project budget.
- 4. Incomplete applications or missing information may result in ineligibility for consideration.

Grant Reporting

While no formal report is required for this grant, we would love the opportunity to rejoice with you in the impact of your work. If possible, please share an update on how the funds were used, ideally six months and again one year after receiving the grant.

You may include a brief summary of your project's progress and outcomes, along with photos, short videos, or human interest stories that we can share through BWNA's newsletter, website, or social media.

Celebrating your success helps us continue supporting and inspiring future projects through this grant program.
